COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

SPD 120 Discerning Your Purpose (Rev. Charli Tupper: Feb 24-Feb 28, 6:45-8:45pm)

The spiritual path diverges in many ways. Discerning which path to take is both a reflective and an action-packed process. This course provides a process for challenging your thoughts and desires along with accountability steps to manifest that achievement. Students will explore their skills, abilities and spiritual gifts while discovering the 'next steps' for progressing to the desired outcome.

SPD 105 Meditation Practices: (Rev. Robert Brumet: Feb 25-Mar 1, 10-11:50am)

This course focuses on the practice and the experience of various forms of meditation. Benefits of the various forms of meditation will be explored as well as methods to deal with resistance to it. There will also be helpful tips for developing a regular meditation practice. Practicing the Silence, Unity's meditation practice, is fundamental and foundational to Unity teachings. Therefore, it will be the primary meditation practice for the duration of the course.

SPD 110 Self-Awareness: (Rev. Robert Brumet: Feb 25-Mar 1, 1:15-3:05pm)

This is a survey course in the practical application of self-awareness and spiritual principles to promote and restore wholeness, balance, and optimal functioning in the student's life. We study various systems and techniques of self-awareness and explore the integration of spiritual principles into each of them.

Required Text: *Living in Balance: A Dynamic Approach for Creating Harmony & Wholeness in a Chaotic World* by Joel Levey and Michelle Levey; *The Enneagram: The Definitive Guide to the Ancient System for Understanding Yourself and the Others in Your Life* by Helen Palmer

SCS 100 Bible Overview of Hebrew Scriptures: (Rev. Kim O'Conner: Feb 25-Mar 1, 1:15-3:05pm)

The Hebrew Scriptures (known as the "Old Testament" in the Christian world) are the root of three major world religions - Judaism, Christianity and Islam. Hebrew Scriptures are a collection of fascinating and sometimes confusing stories, poetry wisdom sayings and inspired visions. Students will explore the history and development of Hebrew Scriptures, thereby acquiring a solid foundation for continuing study and exploration.

SCS 115 Bible Interpretation: Acts to Revelation (Rev. Charli Tupper: Feb 25-Mar 1, 3:15-5:05pm)

Unity's "maieutic" and metaphysical approach to interpreting scriptures aims to help the interpreter cultivate self-knowledge and make contact with the Higher Spiritual Self commonly called "Christ within" and "Christ consciousness". Students discover inner spiritual meanings of Christian Scriptures (Acts through Revelation) as they continue to apply the Unity method of interpretation to Christian Scriptures, "the New Testament." **Required Text:** *NRSV Bible* **Recommended:** *Metaphysical Bible Dictionary*; *The Revealing Word* by Charles Fillmore

MEET the instructors



Rev. Robert Brumet is a teacher, writer and spiritual director. He conducts a variety of retreats, seminars and classes that focus on meditation, self-awareness and spiritual development. Robert has presented his programs at over 150 churches and retreat centers throughout the US, Canada, and the Caribbean.

Rev. Robert was Chairman of Pastoral Studies at Unity Institute and Seminary, where he taught from 1989 to 2016. He is the author of four books and over a dozen magazine articles. He is a teacher of Insight Meditation with certification from Spirit Rock Meditation Center. He is also a Spiritual Director, with certification from Mt St Scholastica College. Rev. Robert was ordained a Unity minister in 1980 and has served churches in Indiana and Kansas. He has B.S. and M.S. degrees from the University of Toledo.

Rev. Kim O'Connor is an ordained Unity Minister and a graduate of the Ministerial Education Program at Unity Institute. She has served as Pastoral Care Minister at Unity of Sun City, Director of Pastoral Care Services at Unity Center of Hope in addition to serving as a Hospice Chaplain with the Banner Health system.

Rev. Kim has served as a supporting Minister for various Unity Churches in the Phoenix area giving Sunday talks and facilitating workshops. Currently, Rev Kim serves as Adjunct Minister at Unity of Phoenix where she supports the ministry by teaching many and various SEE classes. What inspires her most about Unity is that the Unity teachings empower, encourage, and support everyone to discover their own innate divinity and to live life more abundantly.



Rev. Charli Tupper served in various capacities at Unity of Prescott for 19 years, 11 as a minister. She entered Unity's Field Licensing program in 2005 and was ordained in 2009. During her tenure at Unity of Prescott, she served as associate minister, transitional minister, and co-minister. Her passion is teaching and facilitating processes through which students have a transformational experience and an experience of the Presence of God. She is currently supporting a variety of ministries throughout Arizona by speaking on Sundays and facilitating retreats. She also serves as a chaplain for Maggie's Hospice in Prescott.
